5. Issues

The *Regulation respecting greenhouse gas emissions from motor vehicles*, published in the Quebec Official Gazette December 30, 2009, came into effect January 14, 2010. The regulation establishes standards for average greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) for motor vehicles sold, leased or marketed in Quebec by car manufacturers for 2010 to 2016 model years.

The main objective of the *Draft regulation to amend the Regulation respecting greenhouse gas emissions from motor vehicles* is to consider the motor vehicle fleet of manufacturers who conform to federal greenhouse gas emission regulations for passenger vehicles and light trucks for model years 2012 - 2016 to also conform to Quebec standards.

It also allows manufacturers to reach agreement with the Minister of Sustainable Development, Environment and Parks over the data and documents that will be conveyed to the ministry so that it can develop a per-manufacturer GHG emission estimate for all vehicles sold in Quebec.
